- Please DO NOT leave donations outside of the store before or after donation hours when the donation line is closed, as they are exposed to the elements and may also be vandalized or stolen.
- Please understand that we may not be able to accept donations that we deem unsafe or un-sellable – Unacceptable items may be taken The Custer Road Transfer Station- see below for details.

By taking a few moments to review our list of un-accepted items and abiding by our donation procedures, you are doing your part to help us fulfill our mission.

While we will try our best to work with your schedule, pickup appointments are typically scheduled to take place 7-14 days from initial contact. Due to safety concerns, our drivers are restricted from picking up items on the second floor.
